## HOW TO ENTER AND FEES

To enter email images of your work with title, medium, size and price inc commission (you may enter as many entries as you like but only one may be selected). You will be notified of selection by 7 August 2010. No cost enter. If selected the cost is \$40.

## FORMAT

Work can be any size, medium, theme as long as it utilizes a found object.

## COMMISSION ON SOLD WORKS

30% commission on works sold. Payment for work will be made by 30 Sep 2010.

## DELIVERY

If selected works must be delivered to the gallery Friday 27 Aug at 10am. Interstate and Country artists should post or courier it so it arrives before Wed 25 Aug 2010. Your name, title of the work, size and price must be on the back of each work. If this is not done the work will not be displayed and your fee will not be refunded.

## COLLECTION

Melbourne Artists: Unsold works must be collected from BSG, 322 Brunswick St, Fitzroy on Thursday 9 September 2010 4pm to 6pm. Work not collected by this date will be charged a \$25 late fee. Works not collected by 30 September 2010 will be disposed of. Interstate & Country Artists: We will post back any works unsold COD if size permits. If not, you will need to organise a courier. Please email your address for return.
